- The curriculum reflects equality and diversity through the quality of the teaching and learning, opportunities for the pupils to discuss issues. The impact of this is 4 reported incidents of racism over the academic year 2017-2018, none were repeated because children understood why commenting on skin colour was not appropriate after discussion.
- Children are taught about British Values of tolerance and consequences of prejudice during assemblies.
- KS2 results show disadvantage children achieving 100% expected standards combined.
- International day, celebration of Diwali, visits to a mosque and church promote understanding of different cultures.
- Children see positive role models within staff who have disability.
