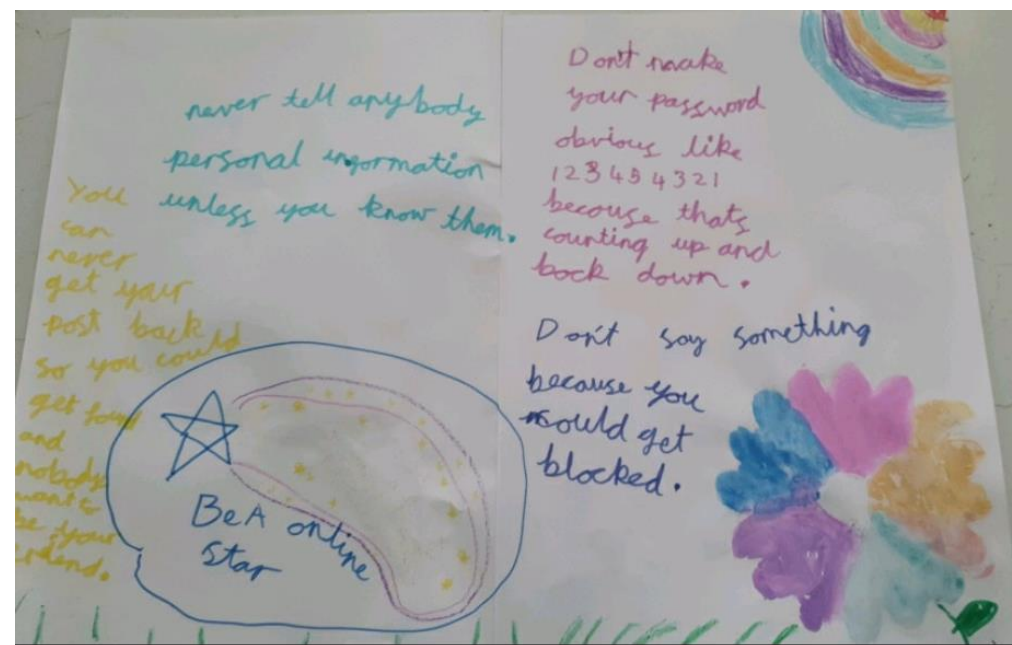
Online safety

- .check the comments on websites before you buy anything because if there new because people might scam you



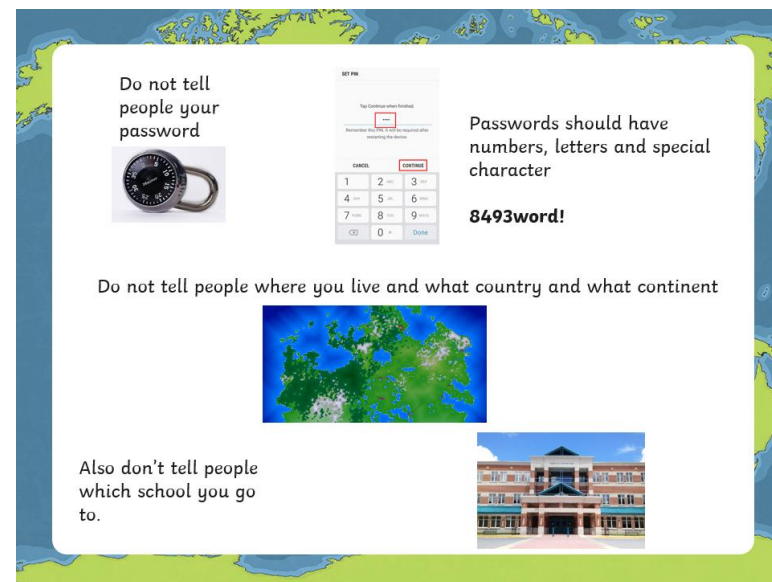

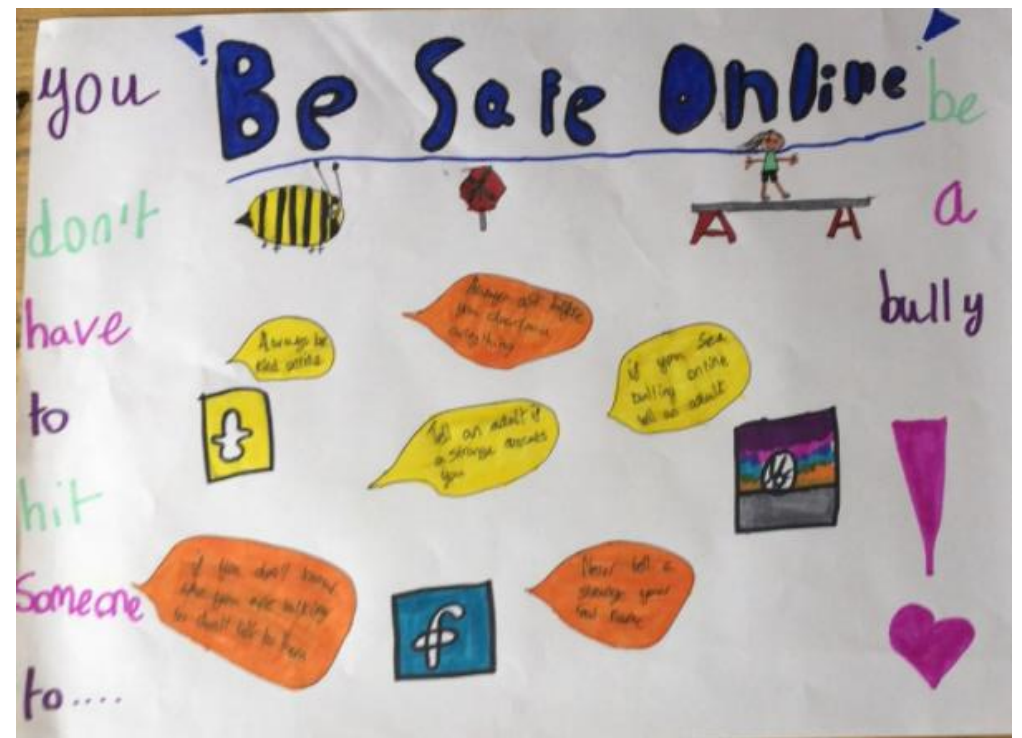
