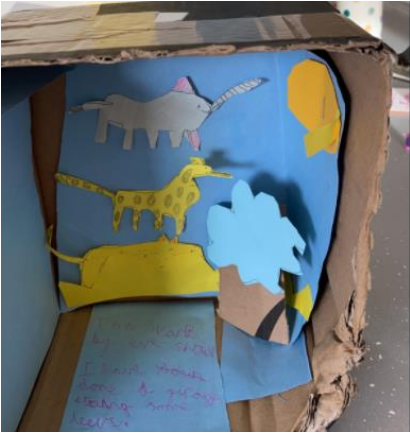


Year 2 - Wonderful Wednesday
