Eco-Schools Topic:
Marine

Aim: We would like to reduce the plastic waste generated by packed and school lunches. We would like to organise a litter pick around a river or beach.

Action(s):

Liaise with Kitchen staff to find out how to reduce plastic in school lunches
Inform school of how to reduce waste in packed lunches.
Help organise waste disposal for lunches.
Identify and organise a litter pick around a river or beach.

How long will it take?

We will aim to make and implement changes by March 2022 to allow kitchen staff to introduce changes within their organisation and children to advertise packed lunch ideas.

Who is responsible?

Surveys from classes. We will review plastic use in lunches using an audit.

Aim: We would like to monitor our energy use more regularly.
We would like to get a renewable energy source for school and make sure our energy supply is from renewable sources where possible.

Action(s):

Fundraise for a renewable energy source – ideally solar panels.

Look into energy suppliers

Organise events to reduce consumption and raise awareness.

Appoint monitors to record energy consumption

How long will it take?

It may take over a year to fundraise enough money.

We will monitor energy over a year

Who is responsible?

Eco-committee, Energy monitors, school staff and FOGL support

How we will monitor progress:

Record energy consumption monthly

More awareness visuals around school.

Consider money saved by school.

Evaluation:

Arrange regular litter picks by all classes.

Organise a competition

Check bins are emptied regularly.

How long will it take?
