English and Communication	Write a diary entry in first person, explaining the changes you have had to make whilst living during WW2.	Find out about Morse code and write a sentence using it.
Maths and Problem Solving	Find out about the currency used during WW2. Create a table that shows its modern equivalents and create a worded Maths problem.	Find out about the foods that were rationed in WW2 and the amounts people were allowed. Convert their units into kilograms or grams.
Science and outside environment	Check and record the weather forecast for a week. Did you record any weather conditions that may have helped or hindered the war efforts?	Soldiers needed uniforms and parachutes, so there was little material left to make everyday clothes. People on the Home Front were encouraged to 'make do and mend'. E.g. string was used to hold up socks, pants and trousers. Find out other ways in which people used to make do or mend.
